#### Restoration of Stroller

One of our items currently on exhibit in *Playing Favorites:100 Great Artifacts* is John and Wilhelmina Randolph's twin carriage. There is a small parasol over each baby's head; these are made from silk but are shattered and very fragile. The conservation treatments for the carriage will stabilize the basket to the stroller base, along with replacing the fabric on the parasols. All parts that are replaced or removed due to damage will still remain with the artifact for future documentation. This conservation is estimated to cost \$8,000. Gifts of any size are welcome.

# Window Project

The Old Courthouse Museum has 61 stained glass windows in the Law Library, Courtroom, first floor hall-ways, and exhibit galleries that contribute to the historic architecture of the building. The windows were designed in six different patterns. Although there are some patterns that are repeated, each window is unique. In 2021 the Museum began a process of restoring and cleaning the historic windows. Ten were completed in the first two years of the project. This painstaking restoration costs approximately \$2,000 per window and will continue for a number of years. Gifts of any size are welcome to contribute to this ongoing project.

# Bring Back the Music!

For 33 years, the Siouxland Heritage Museums have brought free folk, jazz, and traditional music to the public at the Old Courthouse Museum. The annual Winter Concert Series is scheduled to begin November 24th and run Fridays through February. The series is free to the public and is supported by donations and sponsorships. # Project Completed: HOBO Data Logger Update

One of the goals listed in the Conservation Assessment Program report completed in 2023 was to update and add better data loggers to exhibit and storage spaces where artifacts are housed. A generous donation to the Siouxland Heritage Museums Alliance provided funding to purchase 22 HOBO Data Loggers that record relative humidity and temperature and 10 loggers that also measure UV light exposure. This \$6,000 investment in these data loggers will help us manage the condition of the artifacts at all three museum locations and continue our mission of preservation.
